According to the Education Act, the Medical Services for Students (EMI) must provide health promotion and prevention services to pupils during school hours.

A National Quality Register, EMQ, is in place to continuously improve work on student health. The purpose of the quality register is to enable continuous improvement efforts and create equal student health, and it also enables research.

Health data collected from health examinations and health interviews are compiled in the quality register. Student health outcomes can only be seen at the group level, which means that individual pupils cannot be identified.

Talk to the school nurse if you do not want to be included in the register.
